# MN-WI investing focus of event

Organizations in Minnesota and Wisconsin are launching a new event next month that seeks to raise awareness about opportunities for investing in startups across state lines.

The Wisconsin Angel Network, a group of individual investors, has been co-hosting such events in Illinois for more than a year, said Joe Kremer, director of the network. With that success under its belt, the group decided to look to its neighbor to the north next.

The event includes presentations from winners of the Minnesota Cup as well as the winners from a similar state-sponsored business-idea contest held in Wisconsin. Representatives from universities in both states also will talk about their respective technology transfer programs and how those can be used to launch new startups, Kremer said.
